No Staten Island Rail Service at Ferry Terminal

Beginning at 9:00 p.m. Friday, April 5 through 5:00 a.m. Monday, April 8, there will be no Staten Island Railroad (SIR) service into or out of the St. George Ferry Terminal. This shut down of rail service is required to permit the removal of the construction shielding that was installed above the station platforms to protect SIR riders, employees and equipment during the renovation of the ferry terminal ramps above. To accommodate travelers, shuttle buses will be provided continuously between the SIR Tompkinsville Station and the St. George Ferry Terminal throughout the weekend. Passengers will be picked-up and dropped-off in St. George at Bus Station North. SIR staff will be on hand to direct passengers to this location.
