We also heard from staff members who have volunteered previously that they enjoyed the opportunity to interact with the new students.

Assistants for Check-In

Volunteers are needed to help welcome students to CSI. Volunteers also work with an Orientation Leader to assist with checking-in new students at the NSO.

Assistants for Lunch

Volunteers are needed to engage and interact with students during lunch and answer questions they may have. Volunteers also help with traffic flow when students arrive on-site and assist with overseeing lunch distribution.

Advisement Supplemental Staff

Volunteers are needed to help students navigate through their Advisement Worksheets and to assist students with the online scheduling of courses using CUNY First. Volunteers also act as a liaison between the students and the professional advisement staff. Volunteers will be contacted for training, if needed.
