Creating a Great Poster Session

Poster presentations differ from paper presentations in that you need to attract the passersby. Your audience is in a different frame of mind than those at a paper presentation. They want to get the idea behind your work quickly and you want to engage your audience more than quickly!! Techniques to accomplish this can range from creating a well-organized, easy to read poster, to presenting your research in a concise effective way. We will look at some online resources that focus on each of these issues along with a discussion as to how this presenter transitioned from a not so nice (actually horrible) looking poster to one that won an award for best poster at an international conference.
