Total Number of Faculty Who Participated by Submitting Student Warnings = 664 (66%)

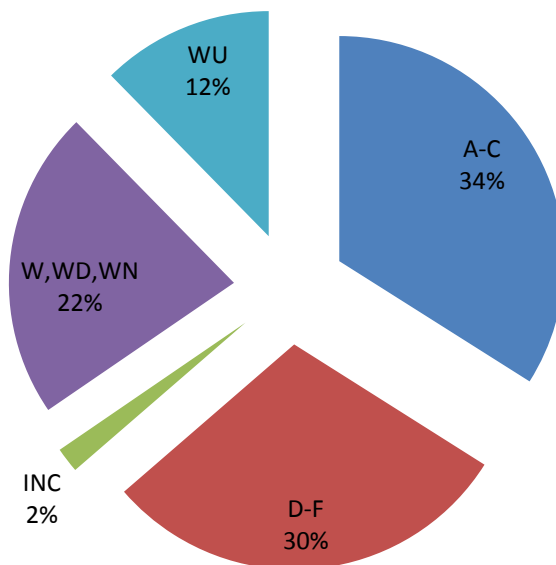
Total Number of Students Placed on Early Alert (Early and Mid-term Warning) = 4392

Total Number of Students Who Engaged with the Early Alert Email Notification = 728 (16%)

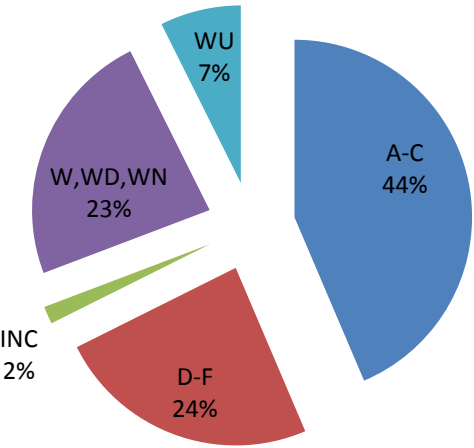
