In the last five years, one million Mexicans residing in the US have returned to Mexico, including children and youth who were born or raised in the US. *Una Vida, dos Países* –a documentary directed by Tatyana Kleyn– presents the stories of these transborder youth, highlighting their experiences living between two countries, cultures, languages and education systems, and exploring their parents' decisions to return to their home country after living undocumented in the US.
