DEAN'S SYMPOSIUM

In the fall of 2015, the Division of Humanities and Social Sciences launched a fellowship to enable faculty members with digital expertise to mentor colleagues who wished to embark on their own digitally enabled projects. A year later, the three inaugural fellows will discuss their progress. A Professor of Psychology is working on a feminist Wikipedia initiative in which she and her students are writing and expanding entries devoted to previously overlooked women in the field of psychology. A Professor of History is creating a digitized archive of oral histories representing Staten Island's diverse religious communities. A Professor of English is creating a Web-based resource for faculty members who are teaching multi-modal composition, in which students not only learn the fundamentals of good writing, but also acquire literacy in various digital platforms.
