Call for Applications

The Provost's Office, the Student Success Task Force, and the Faculty Center for Professional Development will offer an institute for <u>adjunct</u> <u>faculty members</u> in Spring 2017. The focus of the institute will be classbased strategies that support student success. The stipend for adjuncts selected for the Student Success Fellows Institute will be \$400. To receive the stipend, fellows must participate in all three sessions in Spring 2017 and the follow-up meeting in Fall 2017.

The Institute will meet on the following dates: Thursday, February 23; Thursday, March 16; and Thursday, April 27, 2017 from 12:15- 2:00 p.m. in the Faculty Center for Professional Development in the CSI Library (1L). In each of the three workshop sessions, fellows will be exposed to research and data about student success. Members of the CSI Student Success Task Force will share specific strategies that can be embedded into courses from any discipline. Research indicates that these strategies have proven to bridge the achievement gap between groups of students and to increase retention. The February meeting will focus on increasing students' sense of belonging, the March session on learning to learn strategies and techniques, and the final April workshop will be devoted to providing feedback on student success strategies developed by participants.

In addition to participating in the three events in Spring 2017, Student Success Fellows will participate in one session in Fall 2017 (date TBD) to share their experiences integrating strategies into their fall courses.
