



**Issue 1 - The Vision:** In Fall 2017, the College of Staten Island will return to its roots in the North Shore with the opening of CSI St. George. This extension of the CSI campus, located at 120 Stuyvesant Place, will be home to a dynamic 16,000-square-foot facility that is centrally located at the Island’s transportation hub, with convenient access for full- and part-time students from the thriving and diverse community of St. George, as well as individuals commuting from Manhattan, Brooklyn, and the Bronx.

CSI St. George was proposed and developed with the intention of providing convenient access to a high-quality public education to the many residents of the North Shore that are underserved by limited access to opportunities in the area, or that find regular travel to the Willowbrook campus inconvenient. This fact was especially important as our studies determined that these residents have greater economic disadvantages when compared to those residing closer to our main campus. Our goals include providing access, equity, and creating opportunities to work and explore in ways that support the pedagogy of our faculty and the development of skills for success in the classroom and beyond.

The College has made a significant investment in the success of CSI St. George, the residents of the North Shore, and those working and residing in the surrounding neighborhoods and boroughs. We are confident that expansion to St. George will increase the impact that CSI makes on the citizens of the borough and its business community, and will raise the educational horizons and quality of life for our prospective students. We believe this endeavor will be something that all Dolphins, past, present, and future, can be proud of as we look forward to becoming a positive presence in the community of St. George.
