 College of Staten Island.
- 2) A statement of at least 150 words must be included in the nomination packet, detailing how the nominee (individual or group) has made a significant impact in the College of Staten Island campus, local or global community. The award is named in honor of Ellen Krieger, who made a significant impact on the lives of the College of Staten Island's student leaders during her 28 years of service as the Student Government Coordinator.
- 3) If a student is submitting this nomination, a minimum of one letter of recommendation from a member of the CSI administration, faculty or staff must be attached.
- 4) If an administrator, faculty or staff member is submitting this nomination, a minimum of one letter of recommendation from a member of the CSI Student Body.
- 5) Letter(s) of recommendation should outline why the person is being nominated and include a list of the nominee's service to the College of Staten Island community and the qualities that make this person a deserving recipient of this award.
- 6) Letter(s) should be no less than 150 words.
- 7) All nominees will be judged on their merit as outlined in their nomination packet.
- 8) Winners will be notified at the College of Staten Island Student Leadership Summit Awards on Thursday, May 11, 2017 at the Vanderbilt @ South Beach. All nominees will receive an invitation.
- 9) A NOMINATION DOES NOT GUARANTEE AN AWARD.
