### Corelandia- CORE 100 Simulations Game

Corelandia is a radically innovative approach to introducing CSI freshmen to contemporary American constitutional democracy, the struggle for civil rights, and persistent controversies over the economy. Corelandia presents Core 100 students with a post-apocalyptic scenario, within which they re-enact the classic situation of Americans on a new kind of frontier where they have to create a government, a society, and an economy in a setting that makes them choose between conflicting ideologies and moralities. Corelandia successfully debuted in Spring 2017 with over 400 students in Williamson Theater and will be played again in Spring 2018. As part of the Reacting to the Past pedagogy, Corelandia challenges students intellectually and, equally importantly, on a deeply emotional level. At the session, Professor Victor Miller, one of Corelandia's creators, along with Professor Richard Powers, will play a micro game with us to immerse us in the pedagogy, and to provide an overview of how Corelandia meets the teaching and learning objectives of Core 100.
