The Details

Academic Course

In this winter intersession program you will become familiar with and interact with the Cuban educational system through daily observations, seminars, and engagement with K-12 students as well as students enrolled in teacher education programs. You will expand your knowledge of the history and pedagogy of Cuban

education by comparing the Cuban education system with that of the United States. While working in teams with Cuban students and learning from local teachers and faculty, your studies are supplemented with visits to the Literary Campaign Museum as well as Trujillo's former residence within the university's Ciudad Escolar Libertad.

Housing

When you return from class or exploring Havana and the vicinities, you will rest comfortably at your shared apartment.

Exploring

Your exploration of Cuban culture doesn't stop at UCP's campus. Organized excursions on the weekends encourage you to grab your Guayabera and get ready to explore! Some possibilities for field trips include the small, picturesque towns of Viñales and Trinidad, and the city of Santa Clara in the central region of Cuba, site of Che Guevara's mausoleum.
