We are excited to announce that our FIG, CUNY Unlimited- Developing Universal Design Strategies, will have its first meeting of this year this Thursday (02/22) from 12:00-1:00 in 1L-203. This FIG is part of a new initiative at CUNY to develop a meaningful credential for students with intellectual disabilities, CUNY Unlimited/TPSID. The purpose of this FIG is to create a space where faculty can share creative instructional strategies to support neurodiverse students, can learn more about UDL, and can help guide development of more supports for faculty teaching neurodiverse students.
