This course and study abroad program is led by Professor Alan Zimmerman. This trip will combine tours, company visits and lectures to help you understand the context of doing business abroad. The tour will be conducted by Professor Zimmerman and hosted by our study abroad partner, Lorenzo de' Medici - The Italian International Institute in Florence. All of the facilities, including independent administrative offices, classroom buildings and art studios, are located on several premises in the city's historical center in the San Lorenzo area. Florence is a living museum with works by famous painters, sculptors and architects everywhere you turn.





Eligibility Requirements: Completion of premajor requirements for Accounting or Business; 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
