

Major Purpose Definitions:

- 1 Instruction and Departmental Research (I & DR): I&DR includes all faculty teaching and research activity and all non-teaching, full time academic staff from Deans of Divisions to departmental secretaries.
- 2 Academic Support Services: Includes all staffing associated with the Library, organized activities, organized research, and extension and public services. Organzied activities include audio visual services, museums, galleries, and various media organizations.
- 3 Student Services: Includes counseling, financial aid administration, registrar, athletics, international student services, admissions, and student health services, services to students with disabilities, and child care.
- 4 Maintenance and Operations (M&O): Includes administrative, maintenance, and custodial activities associated with college's physical plants.
- 5 General Administration (GA): Includes presidential offices, legal services, fiscal operations, campus development, and grant offices.
- 6 General Institutional Services (GIS): Includes information technology, security, mail and printing, institutional research, public relations, computer and telephone services.
- 7 SEEK & College Discovery: College specific programs and suspense accounts (other).
