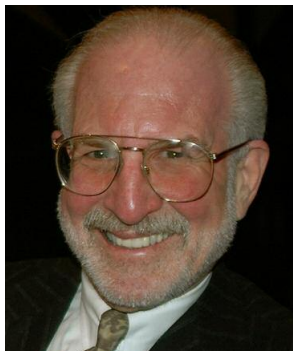

"WILLOWBROOK STATE SCHOOL, THIS MOMENT AND 'LIFE-TIME CARE' AS A HEALTHCARE RIGHT"

William Bronston, MD is a physician who worked at and helped close Willowbrook State School, and is one of the authors of a soon-to-be-published book about Willowbrook. Dr. Bronston will speak about his experiences and their relevance to current efforts to establish universal healthcare as a right, including what we know as "long-term care" in proposed national Medicare for All 2019 legislation (HR1384). The disability community must lead the way in changing Title 19 of the Social Security Act paradigm to demand "life-time-care" and end obligatory out-of-home placement for our sons and daughters, and ourselves.
