Student Leader Positions for the 2020 – 2021 Academic Year

We know that in these challenging times, you may not be thinking about running for a student leader position, but leadership matters! With that in mind, consider running for one of the following student leader positions:

- Student Government (2.25 GPA required; 3.0 for graduate seat)

Freshman (6-29.9 Credits) – 4 seats available

Sophomore (30 – 59.9 Credits) – 4 seats available

Senior (90 Credits and above) – 1 seat available

Graduate – 1 seat available

- CSI Association (2.25 GPA required; 3.0 for graduate student)

Lower Division (up to 59.9 credits) – 2 seats available

Alternate (6 credits and above) – 2 seats available

- College Council (2.5 GPA required; 3.0 for graduate students)

At-Large (no credit requirement) – 2 seats available

In order to run for and hold these positions, CUNY has set the following eligibility requirements:

- You must be matriculated in a degree or credit-bearing certificate program at the College of Staten Island.
- Undergraduate students must carry a minimum of six credit hours.

- Graduate students must carry a minimum of three credit hours and have a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- In order to serve each semester, a student must have completed and earned passing grades in at least fifty percent of the credits for which he or she registered the prior semester, but in no event fewer than three credits.
- GPA requirements vary and are noted on the nomination form.

The completed Nomination Packet, including the candidate platform statement described in “How to Become a Candidate,” must be submitted by 5:00pm on Friday, October 2, 2020. The form can be accessed through the following link:
