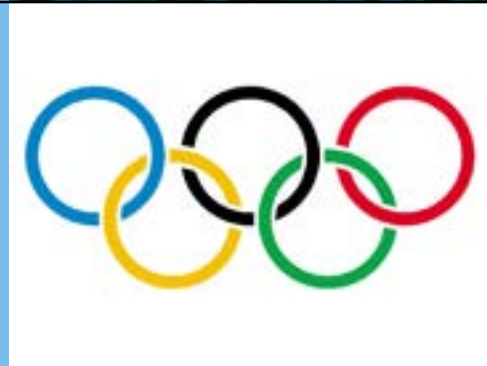


FULBRIGHT U.S. STUDENT PROGRAM OPPORTUNITY
