

Interview Quick Tips

A successful interview requires **preparation** and **professionalism**.

- Thoroughly research the company or program and practice answering common behavioral questions using the STAR method (Situation, Task, Action, Result) to provide structured examples.
- Dress appropriately in business casual or professional attire, arrive early, and maintain positive body language throughout the conversation, including making eye contact and offering a firm handshake.
- Be ready to ask insightful questions about the role and the organization at the end and always follow up with a personalized thank-you note within 24 hours to reiterate your interest.
